Why an Alfa Romeo?

ACTIVE OR PREVENTIVE SAFETY

Driving an ALFA ROMEO is safety in itself because the car responds promptly to the controls and easily solves any problems that may arise on the road or through emergency.

✿ **ROADHOLDING** and stability: well distributed weight - low center of gravity - automatic adjustment of the shock absorbers - action by the suspension and anti-roll bars, aerodynamic body styling to guarantee better adherence to the road.

✿ **MANEUVERABILITY** and acceleration: assurance of always being able to rely on a reflex light response and ease with which the car responds to the drivers control.

✿ **DRIVING COMFORT:** comfortable and richly trimmed passenger section - soundproofed - smooth and flexible operation of controls, light and easy steering - highly sensitive driving.

✿ **BRAKES:** 4 wheels disc. Suspension design, weight distribution and efficient brake system provide for safe control.

PASSIVE OR PROTECTIVE SAFETY

Being in an ALFA ROMEO is safety because of the ability of the car to reduce the effects of accidents, thanks to its structure and other features and comfort.

⊕ **DIFFERENTIATED STRUCTURE:** the front and rear section of the body have been designed to absorb the greater part of the impact and reduce its effects on the passenger section. As a result, passengers receive greater protection and there is less risk of opening or jamming of doors.

⊕ **PARTICULAR FEATURES:** the seats and the passenger section are designed to ensure the absorption of bumps and stresses more easily and safely.

⊕ **STEERING GEAR:** steering box set further back so as to reduce the possibility of damage in case of a frontal impact - short steering column - dished steering wheel.

⊕ **TRIMMINGS:** lack of embellishments and projections both inside and out.
